
The C scale is a time tested way to get into fingerpicking. It looks more complicated than it actually is.




Play the notes in the numbered order.




Use these fingers on these frets.

These are the notes you are playing.



Right Hand:

- 1. First use just your thumb, downstroke only until it's solid.
- 2. Then use just your first finger, upstroke only until it's solid.
- 3. Then alternate between your thumb (downstroke) and first finger (upstroke).

This usually makes a person feel pretty dumb and un-coordinated when you first start. Hang in and give yourself some time to get up to speed where it becomes more satisfying.

Use A Metronome!

It will be slow at first. Use a metronome, start at 40 or 50 beats per minute (BPM) unti you feel solid. Then bring it up 2 or 4 BPM and work that until it's solid. Rinse and repeat until you get up to 80 BPM..

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
